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CENTRAL NEW YORK WOMEN HIGHLIGHT RISK OF ELECTING COLLEEN DEACON

Syracuse, New York –Katko for Congress today released its sixth television advertisement, entitled “Choices,” featuring testimonials of five different Central New York women expressing concern for Colleen Deacon’s candidacy for Congress, highlighting her inability to break with her party and her failure to articulate a plan to defeat ISIS.
